

Personalized Learning Checklist

Bring back the adventure to learning by designing personalized learning environments for your students

- Personal**
In one or more ways learning connects with learner's strengths, beliefs, or interests.
- Choice and Voice**
The learner has the power to choose, make own decisions and voice opinions in the learning process.
- Goals**
The learner set a goal and has check-ins with peers or teacher about the process of reaching the goal.
- Inquiry**
Learner is able to ask relate-able, open-ended questions that will lead to deeper learning.
- Collaboration**
Learner seeks out the help, various perspectives and strengths of others to support learning.
- Authentic**
Learner's work is share in a real-world approach beyond the classroom walls.
- Feedback and Revise**
Learner feels safe to share challenges, take feedback and revise the product.
- Positive Struggle**
The process of learning is valued more than the product. Learners are encouraged to take risks in a safe learning environment.
- Models**
A number of different models are presented to the learner to stimulate ideas and creativity.
- Reflection**
Time is taken for the learner to look back over the process and ponder.
